

## Hypocoi (Tone 2)

Mary and her companions went forth before dawn. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb and heard the angel say, "What do you seek Him as a man among the dead, when He is in Eternal splendor? Behold, the shroud is laid aside. Hasten and proclaim to the world that the Lord is risen and has put Death to death, for He is the Son of God, the Savior of mankind."

## Kondakion of Pascha (Tone 2)

Though You went down in the tomb, O immortal One, You overthrew the power of Hades and rose victorious, O Christ God, You greeted the ointment bearing women, saying: Rejoice! You gave peace to Your apostles, and to those who had fallen, resurrection.

## **Trisagion**

All of you who have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. Alleluia!

# From the Divine Office

Yesterday I was buried with You, O Christ; today I arise with You in Your Resurrection. Yesterday I was crucified with You: glorify me with You, O Savior, in Your Kingdom. (Ode 3)

Before the break of dawn, ointment bearing women hastened to the Sun, who existed before the sun was made, but disappeared for a while in the tomb. They were seeking Him as one would seek the light of day, saying to each other: "Come, friends, let us anoint with spices the body which is a Source of Life, but is now buried, the Body which raised the fallen Adam, but is now lying in the grave. Let us hasten to adore Him as did the wise men and offer Him our gifts of spices. He is now wrapped in a shroud, not in swaddling clothes. Let us cry out and say: 'Arise, O Master, who give to those who had fallen, resurrection!'" (Ikos)



#### **RESURRECTION HOMILY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM**

Let all pious men and lovers of God rejoice in the splendor of this feast. Let the wise servants blissfully enter into the joy of their Lord. Let those who have borne the burden of Lent now receive their pay, and those who have toiled since the first hour, let them now receive their due reward.

Let any who came after the third hour be grateful to join the feast, and those who may have come after the sixth, let them not be afraid of being late, for the Lord is gracious and He receives the last even as the first. He gives rest to him who comes at the eleventh hours as well as to him who has toiled since the first.

Yes, He has pity on the last and He serves the first. He rewards the one and is generous to the other. He repays the deed and praises the effort.

Come you all: enter into the joy of your Lord. You the first and you the last, receive alike your reward. You rich and you poor, dance together. You sober and you weaklings, celebrate the day. You who have kept the fast and you who have not, rejoice today.

The table is richly loaded; enjoy its royal banquet. The calf is a fattened one; let no one go away hungry. All of you enjoy the banquet of faith. All of you receive the riches of his goodness. Let no one grieve over his poverty, for the universal kingdom has been revealed. Let no one weep over his sins, for pardon has shone from the grave.

Let no one fear Death, for the death of our Savior has set us free. He has destroyed it by enduring it. He has despoiled Hades by going down into its kingdom. He has angered it by allowing it to taste of his flesh. When Isaiah foresaw all this he cried out: "O Hades, you have been angered by encountering Him in the nether world.:

Priest: Hades is angered because it is frustrated.

All: It is angered!

Priest: It is angered because it is now captive.

All: It is angered!

**Priest:** It seized a body, and lo! It discovered God. It seized earth, and behold! It encountered Heaven. It seized the visible, and was overcome by the invisible.

O death, where is your sting? Christ is risen and you are abolished.

All: He is truly risen!

Priest: Christ is risen and the demons are cast down.

All: He is truly risen!

**Priest:** Christ is risen and the angels rejoice.

All: He is truly risen!

**Priest:** Christ is risen and life is freed.

All: He is truly risen!

**Priest :** Christ is risen and the tomb is emptied of the dead.

## At the end of the Divine Liturgy

Priest: Christ is Risen! People: He is truly Risen! (three times) Priest: Glory to His Resurrection on the third day! People: We adore His holy Resurrection on the third day!
